
You're on the right place!

CREATE SIMILAR

Super handy command for modelers. Select an element in your model, for example a wall, type CS (stands for create similar), now create a wall of the same type. Fast track modeling, right?


ORIENT TO VIEW

This command is a game changer for navigating a Revit model. You're on a section and want to have a 3D view of that very same situation. Right click on the View Cube, then select the orientation view (in this case the same section you're in) Voilà!



MULTILINE TEXT TAG

You're looking to enter text in multiple lines in a tag. Use Ctrl + Enter when typing in the properties tab and keep typing. Multiline text in parameters made easy!



SCHEDULE SECRET FILTER

Here's a turnaround you can use in Multicategory Schedules. You would normally get a schedule of all you loadable families, but what if you only need 7 categories? Not enough filter slots, right?

Shared Parameters can be filtered in Multicategory schedules as a yes/no filter. Add a shared parameter in those families and use a single Filter by condition in your Schedule properties.


Schedule Properties



SELECTION MANAGEMENT



Working with links, groups, pinned objects etc can be quite hard when selecting.



Check in the Architecture tab, under Modify, your selection preferences. You can also edit them on the view control bar (bottom right of your screen). Also, make sure you uncheck the "Drag elements on selection" option!
